The successful candidate will be an experienced educator with specific qualifications in the area and a demonstrated track record in the development and coordination of innovative programs to support the educational needs of students from diverse cultural and linguistic backgrounds, within a primary school context. Postgraduate certification in EAL/D and or TESOL studies, alongside extensive knowledge and teaching experience of EAL/D pedagogies would be considered essential.

Additionally, an understanding and appreciation of the learning styles of boys would be considered an advantage, and as a member of the TSS team, you will be willing to support the Code of Conduct and stated values and Christian Ethos of the School and must hold Queensland Teacher Registration. Candidate must be able to provide a recent criminal history on request.
